9	(A) designed to steam cook food;
10	(B) operated at a pressure not exceeding five
11	pounds per square inch; and
12	(C) equipped with a safety appliance operated at
13	a pressure not exceeding five pounds per square inch.
14	SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 755.022, Health and
15	Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
16	(a) This chapter does not apply to:
17	(1) boilers owned or operated by the federal

manually fired miniature boilers that:

other than steam collection or liberation drums of process steam

(2) pressure vessels or process steam generators,

- 1 for exhibition, recreation, education, or historical purposes and
- 2 not for commercial use;
- 3 (B) have an inside diameter of 12 inches or less
- 4 or a grate area of two square feet or less; and
- 5 (C) are equipped with a safety valve of adequate
- 6 size, a water level indicator, and a pressure gauge; [or]
- 7 (4) boilers that are designed for operation only at
- 8 atmospheric pressure and that are equipped with two independent
- 9 means to prevent the buildup of pressure; or
- 10 <u>(5) steam cookers</u>.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
