The report must include: 22 (1) an economic impact statement that projects the 23 financial impact of allowing dairy farming in areas determined by the commission by rule to be infected with or at high risk for 24

1 bovine tuberculosis;

2 (2) an assessment of the risk level for bovine
3 tuberculosis presented by areas in Mexico bordering this state;

4 (3) a description of the efforts taken by the Ministry
5 of Agriculture, Livestock, Rural Development, Fisheries and Food
6 and other agencies of the United Mexican States to eliminate bovine
7 tuberculosis in the state of Chihuahua and other areas;

8 (4) a description of the current practices adopted by 9 the United States Department of Agriculture and the commission to 10 eliminate bovine tuberculosis;

(5) an assessment of the risk level for bovine tuberculosis for the state if dairy farming were to occur in areas determined by the commission by rule to be infected with or at high risk for bovine tuberculosis; and

15 (6) an assessment of whether the areas determined by 16 the commission by rule to be infected with or at high risk for 17 bovine tuberculosis could be decreased in size.

18 (d) As soon as practicable, the commission shall present the 19 report regarding the results of the study at an open meeting of the 20 commission.

(e) This Act expires October 1, 2014.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
