5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 51.927, Education Code, is amended by
7	adding Subsection (1) to read as follows:
8	(1) The guidelines established under Subsection (i) must

- 10 (1) review any reports submitted to the board that
- 11 measure and verify cost savings to an institution of higher
- 12 education under an energy savings performance contract; and

require the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board to:

- 13 (2) based on the reports, provide an analysis, on a
- 14 periodic basis, of the cost savings under the energy savings
- 15 performance contract to the governing board of the institution of
- 16 <u>higher education and the Legislative Budget Board until the</u>
- 17 governing board of the institution of higher education determines
- 18 that the analysis is no longer required to accurately measure cost
- 19 savings.

- SECTION 2. Section 2166.406, Government Code, is amended by
- 21 adding Subsection (1) to read as follows:
- (1) The guidelines adopted under Subsection (i) must
- 23 require the State Energy Conservation Office to:
- 24 (1) review any reports submitted to the office that

- 1 measure and verify cost savings to a state agency under an energy
- 2 <u>savings performance contract; and</u>
- 3 (2) based on the reports, provide an analysis, on a
- 4 periodic basis, of the cost savings under the energy savings
- 5 performance contract to the state agency and the Legislative Budget
- 6 Board until the state agency determines that the analysis is no
- 7 longer required to accurately measure cost savings.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
