 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the determination that a voter is deceased.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Section 18.068, Election Code, as added by
 1-24 Chapter 683 (H.B. 174), Acts of the 82nd Legislature, Regular
 1-25 Session, 2011, is amended to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 18.068. COMPARISON OF INFORMATION REGARDING
 1-27 INELIGIBILITY. (a) The secretary of state shall quarterly compare
 1-28 the information received under Section 16.001 of this code and
 1-29 Section 62.113, Government Code, to the statewide computerized
 1-30 voter registration list. If the secretary determines that a voter
 1-31 on the registration list is deceased or has been excused or
 1-32 disqualified from jury service because the voter is not a citizen,
 1-33 the secretary shall send notice of the determination to the voter
 1-34 registrar of the counties considered appropriate by the secretary.

1-35 (b) In making the determination that a voter who has voted
 1-36 within the last four years is deceased under this section, the
 1-37 secretary of state must identify the following information as
 1-38 common to the voter and the deceased person:

- 1-39 (1) the last name;
- 1-40 (2) the date of birth; and
- 1-41 (3) the social security number.

1-42 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-43 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-44 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-45 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-46 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
