A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to an application filed with a county commissioners court

- 3 to revise a subdivision plat; authorizing a fee.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 232.041, Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsections (b-1) and
- 7 (e) to read as follows:
- 8 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (b-1), after [After]
- 9 the application is filed with the commissioners court, the court
- 10 shall publish a notice of the application in a newspaper of general
- 11 circulation in the county. The notice must include a statement of
- 12 the time and place at which the court will meet to consider the
- 13 application and to hear protests to the revision of the plat. The
- 14 notice must be published at least three times during the period that
- 15 begins on the 30th day and ends on the seventh day before the date of
- 16 the meeting. If all or part of the subdivided tract has been sold to
- 17 nondeveloper owners, the court shall also give notice to each of
- 18 those owners by certified or registered mail, return receipt
- 19 requested, at the owner's address in the subdivided tract.
- 20 (b-1) If the commissioners court determines that the
- 21 revision to the subdivision plat does not affect a public interest,
- 22 <u>including an effect on a public road, the notice requirements under</u>
- 23 Subsection (b) do not apply to the application and the
- 24 commissioners court shall provide written notice of the application

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- 1 to the owners of the lots that are within 200 feet of the
- 2 subdivision plat to be revised, as indicated in the most recent
- 3 records of the central appraisal district of the county in which the
- 4 lots are located.
- 5 <u>(e) The commissioners court may impose a fee for filing an</u>
- 6 application under this section. The amount of the fee must be based
- 7 on the cost of processing the application, including publishing the
- 8 notices required under Subsection (b) or (b-1).
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 232.041, Local Government Code, as
- 10 amended by this Act, applies only to an application filed on or
- 11 after the effective date of this Act.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
