- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 25.087, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsections (b-1) and (e) and amending Subsection (d) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (b-1) A school district may adopt a policy excusing a
- 9 student from attending school for service as a student early voting
- 10 clerk in an election.
- 11 (d) A student whose absence is excused under Subsection (b),
- 12 (b-1), (b-2), or (c) may not be penalized for that absence and shall
- 13 be counted as if the student attended school for purposes of
- 14 calculating the average daily attendance of students in the school
- 15 district. A student whose absence is excused under Subsection (b),
- 16 (b-1), [or (b-2), or (c) shall be allowed a reasonable time to make
- 17 up school work missed on those days. If the student satisfactorily
- 18 completes the school work, the day of absence shall be counted as a
- 19 day of compulsory attendance.
- 20 <u>(e) A school district may excuse a student for the purposes</u>
- 21 provided by Subsections (b)(1)(E) and (b-1) for a maximum of two

- SECTION 2. Section 33.092, Education Code, is amended to

- 1 Sec. 33.092. STUDENT ELECTION CLERKS AND EARLY VOTING
- 2 <u>CLERKS</u>. A student who is appointed as a student election clerk
- 3 under Section 32.0511, Election Code, or as a student early voting
- 4 <u>clerk under Section 83.012</u>, Election Code, may apply the time
- 5 served as a student election clerk or student early voting clerk
- 6 toward:
- 7 (1) a requirement for a school project at the
- 8 discretion of the teacher who assigned the project; or
- 9 (2) a service requirement for participation in an
- 10 advanced academic course program at the discretion of the program
- 11 sponsor or a school-sponsored extracurricular activity at the
- 12 discretion of the school sponsor.
- SECTION 3. Subchapter A, Chapter 83, Election Code, is
- 14 amended by adding Section 83.012 to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 83.012. STUDENT EARLY VOTING CLERKS. (a) The early
- 16 voting clerk may appoint student early voting clerks as necessary
- 17 to assist the early voting clerk.
- 18 (b) A person is eligible to serve as a student early voting
- 19 clerk under this section if the person is ineligible to serve as a
- 20 clerk of an election precinct under Section 32.051(c) but meets the
- 21 eligibility requirements to be a student election clerk under
- 22 <u>Section 32.0511.</u>
- 23 <u>(c) A student early voting clerk serving under this section:</u>
- 24 (1) is entitled to compensation under Section 83.052
- 25 in the same manner as other early voting clerks; and
- 26 (2) when communicating with a voter who cannot
- 27 communicate in English, may communicate with the voter in a

- 1 language the voter and the clerk understand as authorized by
- 2 Subchapter B, Chapter 61.
- 3 (d) Not more than four student early voting clerks may serve
- 4 at an early voting polling place.
- 5 (e) The secretary of state may initiate or assist in the
- 6 development of a statewide program promoting the use of student
- 7 early voting clerks appointed under this section.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
