5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 434.017, Government
7	Code, is amended to read as follows:
8	(a) The fund for veterans' assistance is a special fund in
9	the state treasury outside the general revenue fund. The fund is
10	composed of:
11	(1) money transferred to the fund at the direction of
12	the legislature;
13	(2) gifts and grants contributed to the fund;
14	(3) the earnings of the fund;
15	(4) money transferred to the fund from proceeds of the
16	lottery game operated under Section 466.027 or transferred to the
17	<pre>fund under Section 466.408(b); [and]</pre>
18	(5) money deposited to the credit of the fund under
19	Section 502.1746, Transportation Code <u>; and</u>
20	(6) money deposited to the credit of the fund under
21	Section 521.008, Transportation Code.
22	SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
23	is amended by adding Section 521.008 to read as follows:
24	Sec. 521.008. VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION TO FUND FOR VETERANS'

ASSISTANCE. (a) When a person applies for an original or renewal 1 2 driver's license or personal identification certificate under this 3 chapter, the person may make a voluntary contribution in any amount to the fund for veterans' assistance established by Section 4 5 434.017, Government Code. (b) The department shall: 6 7 (1) include space on the first page of each application for an original or renewal driver's license or personal 8 9 identification certificate that allows a person applying for an original or renewal driver's license or personal identification 10 11 certificate to indicate the amount that the person is voluntarily 12 contributing to the fund; and (2) provide an opportunity for the person 13 to contribute to the fund during the application process for an 14 original or renewal driver's license or personal identification 15 16 certificate on the department's Internet website. 17 (c) The department shall send any contribution made under 18 this section to the comptroller for deposit in the state treasury to the credit of the fund for veterans' assistance not later than the 19 14th day of each month. Before sending the money to the fund, the 20 department may deduct money equal to the amount of reasonable 21 expenses for administering this section. 22
