- 1 ASSISTANCE. (a) When a person applies for an original or renewal
- 2 driver's license or personal identification certificate under this
- 3 chapter, the person may make a voluntary contribution in any amount
- 4 to the fund for veterans' assistance established by Section
- 5 434.017, Government Code.
- 6 (b) The department shall:
- 7 (1) include space on the first page of each
- 8 application for an original or renewal driver's license or personal
- 9 identification certificate that allows a person applying for an
- 10 original or renewal driver's license or personal identification
- 11 certificate to indicate the amount that the person is voluntarily
- 12 contributing to the fund; and
- 13 (2) provide an opportunity for the person to

- 17 (c) The department shall send any contribution made under
