- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 76, Education Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Section 76.026 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 76.026. PHARMACY SCHOOL. (a) The board may establish
- 8 and maintain a school of pharmacy as a professional school of the
- 9 <u>institution</u>.
- 10 (b) The board may prescribe courses leading to customary
- 11 degrees offered at other leading American schools of pharmacy and
- 12 may award those degrees.
- 13 (c) The board shall provide for the operations and capital
- 14 expenses of the school to be supported by tuition, gifts, grants,
- 15 and other institutional or system funds available for that purpose,
- 16 except that the school is not eligible for funding under the
- 17 formulas established under Section 61.059 for instruction,
- 18 <u>operations</u>, or <u>infrastructure</u>.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
