S.B. No. 581

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to procedures for securing the deposit of public funds.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 2257.045, Government Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 2257.045. RECEIPT OF SECURITY BY CUSTODIAN. (a) On
- 7 receipt of an investment security, a custodian shall[+
- 8 $\left[\frac{(1)}{(1)}\right]$ immediately identify on its books and records,
- 9 by book entry or another method, the pledge of the security to the
- 10 public entity.
- 11 (b) For a deposit of public funds under Subchapter F, the
- 12 custodian shall issue and deliver to the comptroller a trust
- 13 receipt for the pledged security.
- 14 <u>(c) For any other deposit of public funds under this</u>
- 15 chapter, at the written direction of the appropriate public entity
- 16 officer, the custodian shall:
- 17 (1) [; and
- 18 [(2) promptly] issue and deliver to the appropriate
- 19 public entity officer a trust receipt for the pledged security; or
- 20 (2) issue and deliver a trust receipt for the pledged
- 21 security to the public entity's depository and instruct the
- 22 depository to deliver the trust receipt to the public entity
- 23 officer immediately.
- 24 (d) The custodian shall issue and deliver the trust receipt

- 1 as soon as practicable on the same business day on which the
- 2 investment security is received.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 2257.046, Government Code, is amended by
- 4 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 5 (d) At the request of the appropriate public entity officer,
- 6 the public entity's custodian shall provide a current list of all
- 7 pledged investment securities. The list must include, for each
- 8 pledged investment security:
- 9 <u>(1) the name of the public entity;</u>
- 10 (2) the date the security was pledged to secure the
- 11 public entity's deposit;
- 12 (3) the Committee on Uniform Security Identification
- 13 Procedures (CUSIP) number of the security;
- 14 (4) the face value and maturity date of the security;
- 15 and
- 16 (5) the confirmation number on the trust receipt
- 17 <u>issued by the custodian</u>.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
