with energy conservation or energy efficiency measures.

(e) The commission may use money from the fund to pay the

commission's costs associated with: (1) establishing the program under Subsection (c),

including costs of rulemaking; and

(2) administering the program and fund.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2013.

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
