2	relating to student loan repayment assistance for speech-language
3	pathologists or audiologists employed by a public school or as
4	faculty members of certain programs at public institutions of
5	higher education.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
7	SECTION 1. Chapter 61, Education Code, is amended by adding
8	Subchapter II to read as follows:
9	SUBCHAPTER II. REPAYMENT OF CERTAIN SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGIST
10	AND AUDIOLOGIST EDUCATION LOANS
11	Sec. 61.9811. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
12	(1) "Audiologist" means a person licensed as an
13	audiologist under Chapter 401, Occupations Code.
14	(2) "Communicative disorders program" means:
15	(A) a graduate degree program in audiology or
16	speech-language pathology accredited by the Council on Academic
17	Accreditation in Audiology and Speech-Language Pathology; or
18	(B) an undergraduate degree program that
19	prepares and qualifies students for admission to a graduate degree
20	program described by Paragraph (A).
21	(3) "Public school" means a public preschool or
22	primary or secondary school in this state.
23	(4) "Speech-language pathologist" means a person
24	licensed as a speech-language pathologist under Chapter 401,

- 2 Sec. 61.9812. REPAYMENT ASSISTANCE AUTHORIZED. The board
- 3 shall provide, in accordance with this subchapter and board rules,
- 4 assistance in the repayment of student loans for speech-language
- 5 pathologists and audiologists who apply and qualify for assistance.
- 6 Sec. 61.9813. ELIGIBILITY. (a) To be eligible to receive
- 7 repayment assistance, a speech-language pathologist or an
- 8 <u>audiologist must:</u>
- 9 (1) apply to the board; and
- 10 (2) at the time the speech-language pathologist or
- 11 audiologist applies for the assistance:
- 12 (A) have been employed as a speech-language
- 13 pathologist or as an audiologist, as applicable, for at least one
- 14 year by, and be currently employed in that capacity by, a public
- 15 school; or
- 16 (B) have been employed as a faculty member of a
- 17 communicative disorders program at an institution of higher
- 18 education or private or independent institution of higher education
- 19 for at least one year, and be currently employed in that capacity at
- 20 such an institution.
- 21 (b) The board by rule may provide for repayment assistance
- 22 <u>on a pro rata basis for speech-language pathologists and</u>
- 23 <u>audiologists employed part-time by a public school or institution</u>
- 24 of higher education.
- Sec. 61.9814. LIMITATION. (a) On qualifying for the
- 26 <u>assistance</u>, a speech-language pathologist or an audiologist may
- 27 receive repayment assistance grants for each year of employment,

- 1 not to exceed five years, by:
- 2 (1) a public school; or
- 3 (2) a communicative disorders program at an
- 4 institution of higher education or private or independent
- 5 institution of higher education.
- 6 (b) For each applicable year of employment described by
- 7 Subsection (a), the total amount of repayment assistance grants
- 8 received by a speech-language pathologist or an audiologist under
- 9 this subchapter may not exceed:
- 10 (1) \$6,000 for an eligible recipient who holds a
- 11 <u>master's degree but not a doctoral degree; or</u>
- 12 (2) \$9,000 for an eligible recipient who holds a
- 13 doctoral degree.
- Sec. 61.9815. ELIGIBLE LOANS. The board may provide
- 15 repayment assistance for the repayment of any student loan, as
- 16 defined by board rule, for education at any public or private
- 17 institution of higher education in or outside of this state
- 18 received by an eligible speech-language pathologist or
- 19 audiologist.
- Sec. 61.9816. REPAYMENT. (a) The board shall deliver any
- 21 repayment made under this subchapter in a lump sum payable to:
- 22 (1) the lender and the speech-language pathologist or
- 23 audiologist, in accordance with any applicable federal law; or
- 24 (2) the lender or other holder of the loan on behalf of
- 25 the speech-language pathologist or audiologist.
- 26 (b) A repayment made under this subchapter may be applied to
- 27 the principal amount and accrued interest of the loan.

- 1 Sec. 61.9817. ADVISORY COMMITTEES. The board may appoint
- 2 advisory committees to assist the board in administering this
- 3 subchapter.
- 4 Sec. 61.9818. PROGRAM FUNDING. The program may be funded
- 5 solely from gifts, grants, and donations solicited and accepted by
- 6 the board for the purposes of this subchapter.
- 7 Sec. 61.9819. RULES. (a) The board shall adopt rules
- 8 <u>necessary for the administration of this subchapter.</u>
- 9 <u>(b) The board shall distribute a copy of the rules adopted</u>
- 10 under this section and pertinent information regarding this
- 11 subchapter to:
- 12 (1) each appropriate institution of higher education
- 13 or private or independent institution of higher education;
- 14 (2) <u>any appropriate state agency; and</u>
- 15 (3) any appropriate professional association.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
