5	SECTION 1. Chapter 3, Election Code, is amended by adding

8	(a) In this section, "debt obligation" means an issued public
9	security, as defined by Section 1201.002, Government Code, that is
10	secured by ad valorem taxes.
11	(b) The document ordering an election to authorize a
12	political subdivision to issue debt obligations must distinctly
13	state:
14	(1) the proposition language that will appear on the
15	<pre>ballot;</pre>
16	(2) the purpose for which the debt obligations are to
17	be authorized;
18	(3) the principal amount of the debt obligations to be
19	authorized;
20	(4) that taxes sufficient to pay the annual principal
21	of and interest on the debt obligations may be imposed;
22	(5) a statement of the estimated tax rate if the debt
23	obligations are authorized or of the maximum interest rate of the
24	debt obligations or any series of the debt obligations, based on the

market conditions at the time of the election order; 1 2 (6) the maximum maturity date of the debt obligations to be authorized or that the debt obligations may be issued to 3 4 mature over a specified number of years not to exceed 40; 5 (7) the aggregate amount of the outstanding principal of the political subdivision's debt obligations as of the beginning 6 7 of the political subdivision's fiscal year in which the election is 8 ordered; 9 (8) the aggregate amount of the outstanding interest on debt obligations of the political subdivision as of the 10 11 beginning of the political subdivision's fiscal year in which the election is ordered; and 12 13 (9) the ad valorem debt service tax rate for the political subdivision at the time the election is ordered, 14 expressed as an amount per \$100 valuation of taxable property. 15 SECTION 2. Section 4.003, Election Code, is amended by 16 17 adding Subsection (f) to read as follows: 18 (f) A debt obligation election order required under Section 3.009 shall be posted: 19 20 (1) on election day and during early voting by personal appearance, in a prominent location at each polling place; 21 22 (2) not later than the 21st day before the election, in three public places in the boundaries of the political subdivision 23 24 holding the election; and 25 (3) during the 21 days before the election, on the political subdivision's Internet website, prominently and together 26 27 with the notice of the election and the contents of the proposition,

1 if the political subdivision maintains an Internet website.

2 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 3 an election ordered on or after the effective date of this Act. An 4 election ordered before the effective date of this Act is governed 5 by the law in effect when the election was ordered, and the former 6 law is continued in effect for that purpose.

7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
