- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2703.101(g), Insurance Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (g) For an owner's title insurance policy on residential
- 8 real property that is issued to an individual, the commissioner
- 9 shall adopt terms that provide for continuation of coverage subject
- 10 to rights and defenses against the original named insured for:
- 11 (1) a person who inherits the original named insured's
- 12 title on the original named insured's death;
- 13 (2) the original named insured's spouse who receives
- 14 title in a dissolution of marriage with the original named insured;
- 15 (3) the trustee or successor of a trust established by
- 16 the original named insured to whom the original named insured
- 17 transfers title after the date of policy; [or]
- 18 (4) the beneficiaries of a trust described by
- 19 Subdivision (3);
- 20 (5) a person who receives the original named insured's
- 21 title by gift; or
- 22 (6) an entity to which the original named insured
- 23 transfers title as a capital contribution to the entity [on the
- 24 death of the original named insured].

- 1 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to a title insurance policy
- 2 that is delivered or issued for delivery on or after January 1,
- 3 2014. A title insurance policy delivered or issued for delivery
- 4 before January 1, 2014, is governed by the law as it existed
- 5 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is
- 6 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
