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A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to providing transparency in the budget adoption process
3	of municipalities and counties.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 102.007, Local Government Code, is
6	amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to
7	read as follows:
8	(a) At the conclusion of the public hearing, the governing
9	body of the municipality shall take action on the proposed budget.
10	A vote to adopt the budget must be a record vote.
11	(d) An adopted budget must contain a cover page that
12	includes:
13	(1) one of the following statements in 18-point or
14	larger type that accurately describes the adopted budget:
15	(A) "This budget will raise more revenue from
16	property taxes than last year's budget by an amount of (insert total
17	dollar amount of increase), which is a (insert percentage increase)
18	percent increase from last year's budget. The property tax revenue
19	to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is
20	(insert amount computed by multiplying the proposed tax rate by the
21	value of new property added to the roll).";
22	(B) "This budget will raise less revenue from
23	property taxes than last year's budget by an amount of (insert total
24	dollar amount of decrease), which is a (insert percentage decrease)

The property tax revenue 1 2 to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is (insert amount computed by multiplying the proposed tax rate by the 3 4 value of new property added to the roll)."; or 5 (C) "This budget will raise the same amount of revenue from property taxes as last year's budget. The property tax 6 7 revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is (insert amount computed by multiplying the proposed tax 8 9 rate by the value of new property added to the roll)."; 10 (2) the record vote of each member of the governing 11 body by name voting on the adoption of the budget; (3) the municipal property tax rates for the preceding 12 13 fiscal year, and each municipal property tax rate that has been adopted or calculated for the current fiscal year, including: 14 15 (A) the property tax rate; 16 (B) the effective tax rate; 17 (C) the effective maintenance and operations tax 18 rate; 19 (D) the rollback tax rate; and 20 (E) the debt rate; and (4) the total amount of bonds and other debt 21 obligations owed by the municipality. 22 SECTION 2. Section 102.008, Local Government Code, 23 is 24 amended to read as follows: 25 Sec. 102.008. APPROVED BUDGET FILED WITH MUNICIPAL CLERK: POSTING ON INTERNET. (a) On final approval of the budget by the 26 27 governing body of the municipality, the governing body shall:

file the budget with the municipal clerk; and 1 (1) 2 (2) if the municipality maintains an Internet website, take action to ensure that: 3 4 (A) a copy of the budget, including the cover page, is posted on the website; and 5 6 (B) the record vote described by Section 7 102.007(d)(2) is posted on the website at least until the first anniversary of the date the budget is adopted. 8 (b) The governing body shall take action to ensure that the 9 cover page of the budget is amended to include the property tax 10 11 rates required by Section 102.007(d)(3) for the current fiscal year if the rates are not included on the cover page when the budget is 12 13 filed with the municipal clerk. The governing body shall file an amended cover page with the municipal clerk and take action to 14 ensure that the amended cover page is posted on the municipality's 15 16 website. SECTION 3. Section 111.008, Local Government Code, 17 is amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to 18 read as follows: 19 20 (a) At the conclusion of the public hearing, the commissioners court shall take action on the proposed budget. 21 A vote to adopt the budget must be a record vote. 22 23 (d) An adopted budget must contain a cover page that 24 includes:

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25 (1) one of the following statements in 18-point or
26 larger type that accurately describes the adopted budget:

27 (A) "This budget will raise more revenue from

property taxes than last year's budget by an amount of (insert total 1 2 dollar amount of increase), which is a (insert percentage increase) percent increase from last year's budget. The property tax revenue 3 4 to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is (insert amount computed by multiplying the proposed tax rate by the 5 6 value of new property added to the roll)."; 7 (B) "This budget will raise less revenue from property taxes than last year's budget by an amount of (insert total 8 9 dollar amount of decrease), which is a (insert percentage decrease) percent decrease from last year's budget. The property tax revenue 10 11 to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is 12 (insert amount computed by multiplying the proposed tax rate by the 13 value of new property added to the roll)."; or (C) "This budget will raise the same amount of 14 revenue from property taxes as last year's budget. 3	(4) the total amount of bonds and other debt
4	obligations owed by the county.
5	SECTION 4. Section 111.009, Local Government Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	Sec. 111.009. APPROVED BUDGET FILED WITH COUNTY CLERK:
8	POSTING ON INTERNET. (a) On final approval of the budget by the
9	commissioners court, the court shall:
10	(1) file the budget with the county clerk; and
11	(2) if the county maintains an Internet website, take
12	action to ensure that:
13	(A) a copy of the budget, including the cover
14	page, is posted on the website; and
15	(B) the record vote described by Section
16	111.008(d)(2) is posted on the website at least until the first
17	anniversary of the date the budget is adopted.
18	(b) The commissioners court shall take action to ensure that
19	the cover page of the budget is amended to include the property tax
20	rates required by Section 111.008(d)(3) for the current fiscal year
21	if the rates are not included on the cover page when the budget is
22	filed with the county clerk. The commissioners court shall file an
23	amended cover page with the county clerk and take action to ensure
24	that the amended cover page is posted on the county's website.
25	SECTION 5. Section 111.039, Local Government Code, is
26	amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to
27	read as follows:

1	(a) At the conclusion of the public hearing, the
2	commissioners court shall take action on the proposed budget. \underline{A}
3	vote to adopt the budget must be a record vote.
4	(d) An adopted budget must contain a cover page that
5	includes:

10	(E) the debt rate; and
11	(4) the total amount of bonds and other debt
12	obligations owed by the county.
13	SECTION 6. Section 111.040, Local Government Code, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Sec. 111.040. APPROVED BUDGET FILED WITH OFFICERS: POSTING
16	ON INTERNET. (a) On final approval of the budget by the
17	commissioners court, the court shall:
18	(1) file a copy of the budget with the county auditor
19	and the county clerk; and
20	(2) if the county maintains an Internet website, take
21	action to ensure that:
22	(A) a copy of the budget, including the cover
23	page, is posted on the website; and
24	(B) the record vote described by Section
25	111.039(d)(2) is posted on the website at least until the first
26	anniversary of the date the budget is adopted.
27	(b) The commissioners court shall take action to ensure that

the cover page of the budget is amended to include the property tax 1 2 rates required by Section 111.039(d)(3) for the current fiscal year if the rates are not included on the cover page when the budget is 3 filed with the county clerk. The commissioners court shall file an 4 amended cover page with the county clerk and take action to ensure 5 that the amended cover page is posted on the county's website. 6 7 SECTION 7. Section 111.068, Local Government Code, is amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to 8 9 read as follows: hearing, public 10 (a) At the conclusion of the the 11 commissioners court shall take action on the proposed budget. А vote to adopt the budget must be a record vote. 12 13 (c) An adopted budget must contain a cover page that 14 includes: 15 (1) one of the following statements in 18-point or 16 larger type that accurately describes the adopted budget: (A) "This budget will raise more revenue from 17 property taxes than last year's budget by an amount of (insert total 18 dollar amount of increase), which is a (insert percentage increase) 19 20 percent increase from last year's budget. The property tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is 21 (insert amount computed by multiplying the proposed tax rate by the 22 23 value of new property added to the roll)."; (B) "This budget will raise less revenue from 24 property taxes than last year's budget by an amount of (insert total 25 dollar amount of decrease), which is a (insert percentage decrease) 26 27 percent decrease from last year's budget. The property tax revenue

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to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is 1 2 (insert amount computed by multiplying the proposed tax rate by the value of new property added to the roll)."; or 3 (C) "This budget will raise the same amount of 4 revenue from property taxes as last year's budget. The property tax 5 revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this 6 7 year is (insert amount computed by multiplying the proposed tax rate by the value of new property added to the roll)."; 8 (2) the record vote of each member of the 9 commissioners court by name voting on the adoption of the budget; 10 11 (3) the county property tax rates for the preceding 12 fiscal year, and each county property tax rate that has been adopted 13 or calculated for the current fiscal year, including: (A) the property tax rate; 14 15 (B) the effective tax rate; 16 (C) the effective maintenance and operations tax 17 rate; 18 (D) the rollback tax rate; and 19 (E) the debt rate; and 20 (4) the total amount of bonds and other debt obligations owed by the county. 21 22 SECTION 8. Section 111.069, Local Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 23 Sec. 111.069. APPROVED BUDGET FILED WITH OFFICERS; POSTING 24 25 ON INTERNET. (a) On final approval of the budget by the commissioners court, the court shall: 26 27 (1) file a copy of the budget with the county auditor

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and the county clerk; and 1 2 (2) if the county maintains an Internet website, take action to ensure that: 3 4 (A) a copy of the budget, including the cover 5 page, is posted on the website; and (B) the record vote described by Section 6 7 111.068(c)(2) is posted on the website at least until the first anniversary of the date the budget is adopted. 8 9 (b) The commissioners court shall take action to ensure that the cover page of the budget is amended to include the property tax 10 rates required by Section 111.068(c)(3) for the current fiscal year 11 if the rates are not included on the cover page when the budget is 12 13 filed with the county clerk. The commissioners court shall file an amended cover page with the county clerk and take action to ensure 14 15 that the amended cover page is posted on the county's website. 16 SECTION 9. This Act applies only to a budget adopted for a fiscal year beginning on or after the effective date of this Act. 17 18 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
