14	larger type that accurately describes the adopted budget:

The commissioners court shall file an 21 amended cover page with the county clerk and take action to ensure 22 that the amended cover page is posted on the county's website. 23 24 SECTION 9. This Act applies only to a budget adopted for a fiscal year beginning on or after the effective date of this Act. 25 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
