6	SECTION 1. Section 372.0035, Local Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
8	(d) A municipality that undertakes a project under this
9	section may:
10	(1) adopt procedures for the collection of assessments
11	under this chapter that are consistent with the municipality's
12	procedures for the collection of a hotel occupancy tax under
13	Chapter 351, Tax Code; and
14	(2) pursue remedies for the failure to pay an
15	assessment under this chapter that are available to the
16	municipality for failure to pay a hotel occupancy tax under Chapter
17	351, Tax Code.
18	SECTION 2. Section 351.106, Tax Code, is amended by adding
19	Subsection (c) to read as follows:
20	(c) A municipality to which this section applies:
21	(1) is entitled to receive in the same manner all funds
22	and revenue that a municipality to which Section 351.1015 applies
23	may receive under that section; and
24	(2) may pledge the funds and revenue for the payment of

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## 1 <u>obligations incurred for the construction of qualified projects</u> 2 <u>authorized under that section.</u>

3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
