Section 434.017, Government Code, is amended by 5 6 adding Subsections (c-1) and (c-2) to read as follows: 7 (c-1) Not later than May 1 of each even-numbered year, the 8 commission shall: (1) conduct a needs assessment to identify the 9 10 specific high-priority needs of veterans and the services available to address those needs; 11 12 (2) determine the grant categories that correspond to 13 the high-priority needs identified under Subdivision (1); and 14 (3) identify any gaps between the needs identified 15 under Subdivision (1) and the services available to address those needs. 16 (c-2) The commission shall incorporate the results of the 17 needs assessment and other determinations under Subsection (c-1) in 18 its process for awarding grants from the fund for veterans' 19 20 assistance. SECTION 2. Not later than May 1, 2014, the Texas Veterans 21 22 Commission shall conduct a needs assessment and make other determinations required by Subsection (c-1), Section 434.017, 23 24 Government Code, as added by this Act.
