1-13 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-14 AN ACT

1-15 relating to the board of the Lubbock Reese Redevelopment Authority.  
1-16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
1-17 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 3501.051, Special  
1-18 District Local Laws Code, is amended to read as follows:  
1-19 (a) The board is composed of:  
1-20 (1) five directors appointed by the governing body of  
1-21 the City of Lubbock from a list of persons recommended by the board  
1-22 under this section;  
1-23 (2) one director appointed by the commissioners court  
1-24 of Lubbock County from a list of persons recommended by the board  
1-25 under this section; and  
1-26 (3) the executive director of [one director appointed  
1-27 by] the South Plains Association of Governments.  
1-28 SECTION 2. Section 3501.052, Special District Local Laws  
1-29 Code, is amended by amending Subsections (a) and (c) and adding  
1-30 Subsection (d) to read as follows:  
1-31 (a) A director serves a term of four years. [~~A director~~  
1-32 ~~appointed to fill a vacancy for an unexpired term shall serve for~~  
1-33 ~~the remainder of that term only.~~]  
1-34 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (d), a [A] director may  
1-35 be appointed as the director's own successor for not more than one  
1-36 term.  
1-37 (d) A director appointed to fill a vacancy for an unexpired  
1-38 term shall serve for the remainder of that term and may be appointed  
1-39 as the director's own successor for not more than two terms.  
1-40 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-41 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-42 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-43 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-44 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
