1 AN ACT 2 relating to energy and water management planning and reporting by state agencies and institutions of higher education. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 447.009, Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 Sec. 447.009. ENERGY 7 AND WATER MANAGEMENT PLANNING; REPORTING. 8

9 SECTION 2. Section 447.009, Government Code, is amended by 10 amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (e) to read as 11 follows:

The state energy conservation office shall prepare 12 (c) guidelines for preparation of the plan described in Subsection 13 14 (a)(3) and develop a template for state agencies and institutions of higher education to use in creating the plan. Each state agency 15 16 and institution of higher education shall set percentage goals for reducing the agency's or institution's use of energy and water and 17 include those goals in the agency's or institution's comprehensive 18 energy and water management plan. A state agency or an institution 19 of higher education that occupies a state-owned building shall 20 prepare and implement a five-year energy and water management plan 21 and shall submit that plan to the office upon request. The agency 22 23 or institution shall update its plan annually [biennially]. Α state agency or an institution of higher education that occupies a 24

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building not owned by the state shall cooperate with the office in
addressing the energy or water management of that building.

3 (e) Not later than December 1 of each even-numbered year, 4 the state energy conservation office shall submit a report to the governor and the Legislative Budget Board on the status and 5 6 effectiveness of the utility management and conservation efforts of 7 state agencies and institutions of higher education. The report must include information submitted to the office from each state 8 agency and institution of higher education. The office shall post 9 the report on the office's Internet website. 10

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
