A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to a defense to prosecution for criminal trespass. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 30.05(e), Penal Code, is amended to read 4 as follows: 5 (e) It is a defense to prosecution under this section that 6 the actor at the time of the offense was: 7 (1) a firefighter or emergency medical services 8 9 personnel, as defined by Section 773.003, Health and Safety Code, acting in the lawful discharge of an official duty under exigent 10 11 circumstances; 12 (2) a person who was: 13 (A) an employee or agent of: 14 (i) an electric utility, as defined by Section 31.002, Utilities Code; 15 16 (ii) a telecommunications provider, as defined by Section 51.002, Utilities Code; 17 (iii) a video service provider or cable 18 service provider, as defined by Section 66.002, Utilities Code; 19 (iv) a gas utility, as defined by Section 20 21 101.003 or 121.001, Utilities Code; [or] 22 (v) a pipeline used for the transportation 23 or sale of oil, gas, or related products; or 24 (vi) an electric cooperative or municipally

owned utility, as defined by Section 11.003, Utilities Code; and 1 2 (B) performing a duty within the scope of that 3 employment or agency; or 4 (3) a person who was: 5 (A) employed by or acting as agent for an entity 6 that had, or that the person reasonably believed had, effective consent or authorization provided by law to enter the property; and 7 8 (B) performing a duty within the scope of that 9 employment or agency. SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 10 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 11 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 12 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 13 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 14 For 15 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 16 17 before that date.
