## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the location of certain public sales of real property.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 34.041, Civil Practice and Remedies

5 Code, is amended to read as follows:

6 Sec. 34.041. SALE AT PLACE OTHER THAN COURTHOUSE DOOR.

7 (a) If the public sale of <u>real property</u> [<del>land</del>] is required by <u>court</u>

8 order or other law to be made at a place other than the courthouse

9 door, sales under this chapter shall be made at the place designated

10 by that court order or other law.

11 (b) The commissioners court of a county may designate an 12 area other than an area at the county courthouse where public sales of real property under this chapter will take place that is in a 13 14 public place within a reasonable proximity of the county courthouse as determined by the commissioners court and in a location as 15 16 accessible to the public as the courthouse door. The commissioners court shall record that designation in the real property records of 17 the county. A designation by a commissioners court under this 18 section is not a ground for challenging or invalidating any sale. 19 Except for a sale under Subsection (a), a sale must be held at an 20 area designated under this subsection if the sale is held on or 21 after the 90th day after the date the designation is recorded. The 22 23 commissioners court may by order authorize a county official or

employee to identify separate locations within the designated area

- 1 for the conduct of sales under this section and for the conduct of
- 2 sales by peace officers under other laws.
- 3 SECTION 2. Subsection (h), Section 51.002, Property Code,
- 4 is amended to read as follows:
- 5 (h) For the purposes of Subsection (a), the commissioners
- 6 court of a county may designate an area other than an area at the
- 7 county courthouse where public sales of real property under this
- 8 section will take place that is in a public place within a
- 9 reasonable proximity of the county courthouse as determined by the
- 10 commissioners court and in a location as accessible to the public as
- 11 the courthouse door. The commissioners court shall record that
- 12 designation in the real property records of the county. A
- 13 designation by a commissioners court under this section is not a
- 14 ground for challenging or invalidating any sale. A sale must [may
- 15 not] be held at an area designated under this subsection if the sale
- 16 <u>is held on or after</u> [before] the 90th day after the date the
- 17 designation is recorded. The posting of the notice required by
- 18 Subsection (b)(1) of a sale designated under this subsection to
- 19 take place at an area other than an area of the courthouse remains
- 20 at the courthouse door of the appropriate county.
- SECTION 3. Subsection (r), Section 34.01, Tax Code, is
- 22 amended to read as follows:
- 23 (r) Except as provided by this subsection, a sale of real
- 24 property under this section must take place at the county
- 25 courthouse in the county in which the land is located. The
- 26 commissioners court of the county may designate an area other than
- 27 <u>an area at</u> [in] the county courthouse [or another location in the

1 county] where sales under this section will [must] take place that is in a public place within a reasonable proximity of the county 2 courthouse as determined by the commissioners court and in a 3 location as accessible to the public as the courthouse door. The 4 5 commissioners court [and] shall record that designation [any designated area or other location] in the real property records of 6 the county. A designation by a commissioners court under this 7 8 section is not a ground for challenging or invalidating any sale. A sale must be held at an area designated under this subsection if the 9 sale is held on or after the 90th day after the date the designation 10 is recorded [If the commissioners court designates an area in the 11 courthouse or another location in the county for sales, a sale must 12 occur in that area or at that location. If the commissioners court 13 does not designate an area in the courthouse or another location in 14 15 the county for sales, a sale must occur in the same area in the courthouse that is designated by the commissioners court for the 16 sale of real property under Section 51.002, Property Code]. 17

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect October 1, 2013.
