## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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1	AN ACT
2	relating to the reporting of the hiring of lobbyists on behalf of a
3	governmental entity.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 305.005, Government Code, is amended by
6	amending Subsections (f) and (g-1) and adding Subsection (l) to
7	read as follows:
8	(f) The registration must be written and verified and must
9	contain:
10	(1) the registrant's full name and address;
11	(2) the registrant's normal business, business phone
12	number, and business address;
13	(3) the full name and address of each person:
14	(A) who reimburses, retains, or employs the
15	registrant to communicate directly with a member of the legislative
16	or executive branch to influence legislation or administrative
17	action; and

- 18 (B) on whose behalf the registrant has
- 19 communicated directly with a member of the legislative or executive
- 20 branch to influence legislation or administrative action;
- 21 (4) <u>if applicable:</u>
- (A) an indication that the person identified
- 23 under Subdivision (3) is a governmental entity or an entity that
- 24 reimburses, retains, or employs the registrant on behalf of a

- 2 (B) the name of the governmental entity on whose
- 3 behalf the registrant is reimbursed, retained, or employed;
- 4 (5) the subject matter of the legislation or of the
- 5 administrative action that is the subject of the registrant's
- 6 direct communication with a member of the legislative or executive
- 7 branch and, if applicable, the docket number or other
- 8 administrative designation of the administrative action;
- 9 (6)  $[\frac{(5)}{(5)}]$  for each person employed or retained by the
- 10 registrant for the purpose of assisting in direct communication
- 11 with a member of the legislative or executive branch to influence
- 12 legislation or administrative action:
- 13 (A) the full name, business address, and
- 14 occupation of the person; and
- 15 (B) the subject matter of the legislation or of
- 16 the administrative action to which the person's activities
- 17 reportable under this section were related and, if applicable, the
- 18 docket number or other administrative designation of the
- 19 administrative action; and
- (7) [(6)] the amount of compensation or reimbursement
- 21 paid by each person who reimburses, retains, or employs the
- 22 registrant for the purpose of communicating directly with a member
- 23 of the legislative or executive branch or on whose behalf the
- 24 registrant communicates directly with a member of the legislative
- 25 or executive branch.
- 26 (g-1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section,
- 27 compensation or reimbursement required to be reported under

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- 1 Subsection (f)(7) [(f)(6)] shall be reported as an exact amount if:
- 2 (1) the compensation or reimbursement received
- 3 exceeds \$500,000; or
- 4 (2) the registrant is reimbursed, retained, or
- 5 employed by a governmental entity or by another entity on behalf of
- 6 <u>a governmental entity</u>.
- 7 (1) The reimbursement, retention, or employment of a
- 8 registrant by an attorney to communicate directly with a member of
- 9 the legislative or executive branch to influence legislation or
- 10 administrative action on behalf of a governmental entity is not the
- 11 provision of legal representation subject to attorney-client
- 12 privilege and must be disclosed as required by this section.
- SECTION 2. Section 305.005, Government Code, as amended by
- 14 this Act, applies only to a lobbyist registration or renewal filed
- 15 on or after December 1, 2013.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
