5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 254.036, Election Code, is amended by
7	adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
8	(f) In prescribing the format of a report filed under this
9	chapter with an authority other than the commission, the commission
10	shall ensure that:
11	(1) a report may be filed:
12	(A) by first-class United States mail or common
13	or contract carrier;
14	(B) by personal delivery; or
15	(C) by electronic filing, if the authority with
16	whom the report is required to be filed has adopted rules and
17	procedures to provide for the electronic filing of the report and
18	the report is filed in accordance with those rules and procedures;
19	and
20	(2) an authority with whom a report is electronically
21	filed issues an electronic receipt for the report to the person
22	filing the report.
23	SECTION 2. Section 145.004, Local Government Code, is
24	amended by amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (g) to

2 (d) <u>Except as provided in Subsection (g), the</u> [The]
3 timeliness of the filing is governed by Section 572.029, Government

5 (g) A person is considered to have timely filed a financial
6 statement under this chapter if:

7 (1) the statement is personally delivered not later
8 than 5 p.m. of the last day for filing the statement; or

9 (2) the clerk or secretary of the municipality with 10 whom the statement is required to be filed has adopted rules and 11 procedures to provide for the electronic filing of the statement 12 and the statement is electronically filed in accordance with those 13 rules and procedures not later than midnight of the last day for 14 filing the statement.

15 SECTION 3. Section 159.004, Local Government Code, is 16 amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (e) to 17 read as follows:

(b) <u>Except as provided in Subsection (e), the</u> [The]

21 (e) A person is considered to have timely filed a financial 22 statement under this subchapter if:

Subchapter B, Chapter 159, Local Government 3 Code, is amended by adding Section 159.0341 to read as follows: 4 Sec. 159.0341. TIMELINESS OF FILING. A person is 5 6 considered to have timely filed a report under this subchapter if: 7 (1) the report is filed in accordance with Section 8 572.029, Government Code; 9 (2) the report is personally delivered not later than 10 5 p.m. of the last day for filing the report; or 11 (3) the officer with whom the report is required to be 12 filed has adopted rules and procedures to provide for the electronic filing of the report and the report is electronically 13 14 filed in accordance with those rules and procedures not later than 15 midnight of the last day for filing the report. SECTION 5. Section 159.053, Local Government Code, 16 is 17 amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to read as follows: 18 19 (b) Except as provided in Subsection (c), the [The] 20 timeliness of the filing is governed by Section 572.029, Government 21 Code. (c) A person is considered to have timely filed a financial 22 statement under this subchapter if: 23 24 (1) the statement is personally delivered not later 25 than 5 p.m. of the last day for filing the statement; or 26 (2) the county clerk with whom the statement is required to be filed has adopted rules and procedures to provide for 27

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1 <u>the electronic filing of the statement and the statement is</u> 2 <u>electronically filed in accordance with those rules and procedures</u> 3 <u>not later than midnight of the last day for filing the statement.</u>

4 SECTION 6. (a) Section 254.036, Election Code, as amended 5 by this Act, applies only to a report required to be filed under 6 Chapter 254, Election Code, that is due on or after January 1, 2014. 7 A report required to be filed under Chapter 254, Election Code, that 8 is due before January 1, 2014, is governed by the law in effect on 9 the date the report is due, and the former law is continued in 10 effect for that purpose.

Section 145.004, Local Government Code, as amended by 11 (b) this Act, applies only to a financial statement required to be filed 12 under Chapter 145, Local Government Code, that is due on or after 13 14 January 1, 2014. A financial statement required to be filed under 15 Chapter 145, Local Government Code, that is due before January 1, 2014, is governed by the law in effect on the date the financial 16 17 statement is due, and the former law is continued in effect for that 18 purpose.

19 (c) The changes in law made by this Act to Chapter 159, Local Government Code, apply only to a financial statement or report 20 required to be filed under that chapter that is due on or after 21 January 1, 2014. A financial statement or report required to be 22 filed under Chapter 159, Local Government Code, that is due before 23 24 January 1, 2014, is governed by the law in effect on the date the financial statement or report is due, and the former law is 25 26 continued in effect for that purpose.

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SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.

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
