- 2 relating to a prohibition on the disposal of certain used equipment
- 3 at a municipal solid waste facility; creating an offense.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 361.954(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The collection, recycling, and reuse provisions of this
- 8 subchapter apply to computer equipment used and returned to the
- 9 manufacturer by a consumer in this state and, except as provided by
- 10 <u>Section 361.967</u>, do not impose any obligation on an owner or
- 11 operator of a solid waste facility.
- 12 SECTION 2. Subchapter Y, Chapter 361, Health and Safety
- 13 Code, is amended by adding Section 361.967 to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 361.967. PROHIBITION ON LAND DISPOSAL OR INCINERATION.
- 15 (a) In this section, "used equipment" means equipment that is
- 16 eligible for collection under a manufacturer's recovery plan
- 17 adopted under Section 361.955.
- (b) The commission by rule shall prohibit a person from
- 19 intentionally or knowingly disposing of used equipment in a
- 20 <u>municipal solid waste landfill or incinerator.</u>
- 21 (c) An owner or operator of a municipal solid waste landfill
- 22 or incinerator is not in violation of this section or a rule adopted
- 23 under this section if the owner or operator has:
- 24 (1) posted in a conspicuous location a sign stating

- 1 that used equipment is not accepted at the landfill or incinerator;
- 2 and
- 3 (2) notified in writing any solid waste collector
- 4 registered to dispose of waste at the landfill or incinerator that
- 5 used equipment is not accepted.
- 6 (d) A person that violates this section or a rule adopted
- 7 under this section is liable for a civil penalty not to exceed \$200
- 8 for each item of used equipment disposed of or accepted for disposal
- 9 at a municipal solid waste landfill or incinerator.
- SECTION 3. Section 361.973(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- 12 (a) Except as provided by this section and Sections
- 13 [Section] 361.991 and 361.993, this subchapter applies only to
- 14 covered television equipment that is:
- 15 (1) offered for sale or sold to a consumer in this
- 16 state; or
- 17 (2) used by a consumer in this state and returned for
- 18 recycling.
- 19 SECTION 4. Subchapter Z, Chapter 361, Health and Safety
- 20 Code, is amended by adding Section 361.993 to read as follows:
- 21 Sec. 361.993. PROHIBITION ON LAND DISPOSAL OR INCINERATION.
- 22 (a) In this section, "used equipment" means covered television
- 23 equipment that is eligible for collection under:
- (1) a manufacturer's recovery plan adopted under
- 25 Section 361.978; or
- 26 (2) a manufacturer recycling leadership program
- 27 established under Section 361.979.

- 1 (b) The commission by rule shall prohibit a person from
- 2 intentionally or knowingly disposing of used equipment in a
- 3 municipal solid waste landfill or incinerator.
- 4 (c) An owner or operator of a municipal solid waste landfill
- 5 or incinerator is not in violation of this section or a rule adopted
- 6 under this section if the owner or operator has:
- 7 (1) posted in a conspicuous location a sign stating
- 8 that used equipment is not accepted at the landfill or incinerator;
- 9 and
- 10 (2) notified in writing any solid waste collector
- 11 registered to dispose of waste at the landfill or incinerator that
- 12 <u>used equipment is not accepted.</u>
- 13 (d) A person that violates this section or a rule adopted
- 14 under this section is liable for a civil penalty not to exceed \$200
- 15 for each item of used equipment disposed of or accepted for disposal
- 16 <u>at a municipal solid waste landfill or incinerator.</u>
- 17 SECTION 5. The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality
- 18 shall adopt rules to implement this Act not later than December 31,
- 19 2013.
- 20 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
