- 9 (1) "State agency" has the meaning assigned by Section
- 10 2103.001.
- 11 (2) "Volunteer firefighter" means a member of a
- 12 volunteer fire department who is not a full-time paid employee.
- 13 (b) A state agency may not:
- 14 (1) require a volunteer firefighter to obtain a
- 15 license or certification in order to be a volunteer firefighter; or
- 16 (2) require a member of an industrial emergency
- 17 response team to obtain a license or certification in order to be a
- 18 member of an industrial emergency response team.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
