The change in law made by this Act to Section 61.833(b), Education Code, applies beginning with the 2013 fall 19 semester. A semester or other academic term before the 2013 fall 20 21 semester is covered by the applicable law as it existed before the effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in 22 23 effect for that purpose. 24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
