1 (iii) that borders the Gulf of Mexico. 2 SECTION 2. Subchapter Z, Chapter 552, Local Government Code, is amended by adding Section 552.914 to read as follows: 3 Sec. 552.914. UTILITY CONTRACTS FOR CERTAIN 4 MUNICIPALITIES. (a) In this section, "utility system" means an 5 electric, water, sewer, solid waste disposal, drainage utility, or 6 7 natural gas system, or any combination of those systems. (b) This section applies only to a municipality described by 8 Section 1502.070(a)(2)(C), Government Code. 9 (c) Notwithstanding any limitation provided by a home rule 10 charter, the governing body, board of trustees, or other entity 11 vested with the management and control of the municipality's 12 13 utility system may contract for the purchase of electricity under terms the governing body, board of trustees, or other entity 14 15 considers appropriate. 16 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
