A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to a defense to prosecution of the offense of Medicaid 3 fraud.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. SECTION 35A.02, Penal Code, is amended by adding 6 Subsection (g) to read as follows:

7 (g) It is not a defense to prosecution under this chapter 8 that the Medicaid program has received or recouped funds 9 representing repayment for the fraudulent act or acts, in whole or 10 in part, which are the basis for the criminal charge for which the 11 defendant is indicted.

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to 12 13 an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed 14 15 by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of 16 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of 17 this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date. 18 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
