- 1 to an insurance policy, agreement, contract, evidence of coverage,
- 2 or other plan document delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed
- 3 on or after January 1, 2014. An insurance policy, agreement,
- 4 contract, evidence of coverage, or other plan document delivered,
- 5 issued for delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2014, is governed
- 6 by the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this
