1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1-20 AN ACT

relating to the disposal of demolition waste from abandoned or nuisance buildings by certain local governments.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 1-21 1-22 1-23

SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 361.126, Health and Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:

- (b) The commission may issue a permit by rule to authorize the governing body of a county or municipality with a population of $\frac{12,000}{1000}$ or less to dispose of demolition waste from a building if the disposal occurs on land that:
 - (1)the county or municipality owns or controls; and
- (2) would qualify for an arid exemption under commission rules.

1-32 1-33 This Act takes effect immediately if it receives SECTION 2. 1-34 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-35 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-36 1-37 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
