1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the disposal of demolition waste from abandoned or  
 1-22 nuisance buildings by certain local governments.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 361.126, Health and  
 1-25 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-26 (b) The commission may issue a permit by rule to authorize  
 1-27 the governing body of a county or municipality with a population of  
 1-28 12,000 [~~10,000~~] or less to dispose of demolition waste from a  
 1-29 building if the disposal occurs on land that:

1-30 (1) the county or municipality owns or controls; and

1-31 (2) would qualify for an arid exemption under  
 1-32 commission rules.

1-33 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-34 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-35 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-36 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-37 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
