1	AN ACT
2	relating to use of telemedicine in certain trauma facilities.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 773, Health and Safety
5	Code, is amended by adding Section 773.1151 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 773.1151. USE OF TELEMEDICINE BY CERTAIN TRAUMA
7	FACILITIES. (a) In this section, "telemedicine medical service"
8	means a health care service that is initiated by a physician to
9	provide patient assessment, diagnosis, consultation, or treatment
10	or to transfer medical data and that requires the use of advanced
11	telecommunications technology, other than telephone or facsimile
12	technology, including:
13	(1) compressed digital interactive video, audio, or
14	data transmission;
15	(2) clinical data transmission using computer imaging
16	by way of still-image capture and store and forward; and
17	(3) other technology that facilitates access to health
18	care services or medical specialty expertise.
19	(b) A health care facility designated as a level IV trauma
20	facility and located in a county with a population of less than
21	50,000 may provide medical care to patients through the use of
22	telemedicine medical services provided by an on-call physician who
23	has special competence in the care of critically injured patients.

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(c) Department rules may not, as part of the requirements

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- 1 for designation of the facility as a level IV trauma facility,
- 2 require the physical presence or physical availability of a
- 3 physician described by Subsection (b) and may not prohibit the use
- 4 of telemedicine medical services that meet the requirements of
- 5 Subsection (b).
- 6 SECTION 2. The executive commissioner of the Health and
- 7 Human Services Commission shall adopt rules to implement Section
- 8 773.1151, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, not later
- 9 than December 1, 2013.
- 10 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding Section 773.1151, Health and
- 11 Safety Code, as added by this Act, a level IV trauma facility
- 12 located in a county with a population of less than 50,000 may only
- 13 use telemedicine medical services for the purposes authorized by
- 14 that section on or after January 1, 2014.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
