1-17 relating to the confidentiality of certain grand juror information.
 1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-19 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Article 19.42, Code of Criminal
 1-20 Procedure, is amended to read as follows:
 1-21 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), information
 1-22 collected by the court, court personnel, or prosecuting attorney
 1-23 during the grand jury selection process about a person who serves as
 1-24 a grand juror, including the person's name, home address, home
 1-25 telephone number, social security number, driver's license number,
 1-26 and other personal information, is confidential and may not be
 1-27 disclosed by the court, court personnel, or prosecuting attorney.
 1-28 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-29 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-30 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-31 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-32 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.

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
