An insurer making the election must 20 21 comply with Section 1812.003. 22 (b) On request of and at no cost to an insured, an insurer shall provide to the insured a copy of a specimen policy applicable

- 15 (1) preserve an electronic copy of the specimen
- 16 policy; and
- 17 (2) make a printed or electronic copy of the specimen
- 18 policy available on request at no cost.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to an insurance policy that
- 20 is delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or after the
- 21 effective date of this Act. A policy delivered, issued for
- 22 delivery, or renewed before the effective date of this Act is
- 23 governed by the law as it existed immediately before the effective
- 24 date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that
