- Δ BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. The heading to Section 1201.109, Insurance Code, 5
- is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 1201.109. NOTICE OF RATE INCREASE FOR MAJOR MEDICAL 7
- EXPENSE INSURANCE POLICY. 8
- SECTION 2. Section 1201.109, Insurance Code, is amended by 9
- amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (f) to read as 10
- follows: 11

- Not less than 60 days before the date on which a premium 12
- 13 rate increase takes effect on an individual accident and health
- insurance policy that provides major medical expense coverage and 14
- 15 that is delivered or issued for delivery in this state by an
- insurer, the insurer shall: 16
- (1) give written notice to the 17 insured of the
- effective date of the increase; and 18
- (2) provide the insured a table that clearly lists: 19
- (A) the actual dollar amount of the premium on 20
- the date of the notice; 21
- 22 (B) the actual dollar amount of the premium after
- 23 the premium rate increase; and
- 24 (C) the percentage change between the amounts

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- 1 described by Paragraphs (A) and (B).
- 2 <u>(f) For purposes of this section, "major medical expense</u>
- 3 <u>coverage" means an individual major medical expense insurance</u>
- 4 policy to which this chapter applies under Section 1201.003 that
- 5 constitutes creditable coverage under Section 1205.004.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
