A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1-19 1-20 AN ACT

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relating to the administration and management of elections and public information of the El Paso County Water Improvement District No. 1.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 9303.001, Special District Local Laws Code, is amended to read as follows:

001. <u>DEFINITIONS</u> [<u>DEFINITION</u>]. In this chapter: "Board" means the district's board of directors. Sec. 9303.001. (1)

"Director" means a board member.

(3) "District"[, "district"] means the El Paso County

Water Improvement District No. 1.

SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 9303, Special District Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Sections 9303.053 and 9303.054 to read as follows:

Sec. 9303.053. ADMINISTRATION OF ELECTIONS. (a) district shall contract with the elections administrator of El Paso County to conduct an election held by the district.

(b) The district shall pay the costs of an election

an election conducted under Subsection (a).

Sec. 9303.054. PUBLIC INFORMATION. (a) The district shall

maintain an Internet website.
(b) The board shall make available on the district's Internet website:

(1) campaign finance reports for each director;

(2) the meeting agenda and minutes for each meeting held by the board;

archived video and audio for each open meeting held by the board;

(4) the district's budget for the current year; and

(5) any audits of the district.

SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to an open meeting held by the El Paso County Water Improvement District No. 1 on or after the effective date of this Act. An open meeting that is held by that district before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date of the open meeting, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.

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
