## S.B. No. 871

## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT

2 relating to the marketing and advertising of the veterans' 3 assistance lottery game.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subsection (c), Section 466.027, Government 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:

7 (C) The commission shall market and advertise the lottery game operated under this section in a manner intended to inform the 8 9 public that the game tickets are available for purchase and that the 10 game proceeds are used to fund veterans programs in this state. The amount the commission spends on its marketing and advertising 11 12 budget to promote the game operated under this section shall be 13 equivalent to the amount the commission spends to promote any other instant-ticket lottery game operated under this chapter. 14 The game tickets must clearly state that the game proceeds are used to 15 benefit the veterans in this state. The Texas Veterans Commission 16 may make recommendations to the Texas Lottery Commission relating 17 to the marketing and advertising of the game. 18

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SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.

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
