1-17 relating to the marketing and advertising of the veterans'
 1-18 assistance lottery game.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Subsection (c), Section 466.027, Government
 1-21 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-22 (c) The commission shall market and advertise the lottery
 1-23 game operated under this section in a manner intended to inform the
 1-24 public that the game tickets are available for purchase and that the
 1-25 game proceeds are used to fund veterans programs in this state. The
 1-26 amount the commission spends on its marketing and advertising
 1-27 budget to promote the game operated under this section shall be
 1-28 equivalent to the amount the commission spends to promote any other
 1-29 instant-ticket lottery game operated under this chapter. The game
 1-30 tickets must clearly state that the game proceeds are used to
 1-31 benefit the veterans in this state. The Texas Veterans Commission
 1-32 may make recommendations to the Texas Lottery Commission relating
 1-33 to the marketing and advertising of the game.

1-34 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.

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
