4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 108, Alcoholic Beverage
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 108.035 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 108.035. CERTAIN PROMOTIONAL ITEMS PROVIDED TO
8	RETAILER BY MANUFACTURER, WHOLESALER, OR DISTRIBUTOR. (a)
9	Notwithstanding any other provision of this code, a manufacturer,
10	wholesaler, or distributor of alcoholic beverages may:
11	(1) sell to a retailer promotional items that bear an
12	alcoholic beverage manufacturer's logo, brand, or product name and
13	are designed:
14	(A) to promote a specific product or brand; and
15	(B) for use by the consumer, either on or off the
16	retailer's premises; and
17	(2) give or sell to a retailer interior signs that have
18	the primary purpose of advertising a brand or product or the price
19	of a brand or product, provided that a sign provided to a retailer
20	under this section may not bear the name, logo, or trademark of a
21	specific retailer.
22	(b) Promotional items sold under Subsection (a)(1) may not
23	be sold for less than the item manufacturer's regularly published
24	wholesale price. Payment for an item sold under this section must be

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1 in cash, paid on or before delivery.

2 (c) A manufacturer, wholesaler, or distributor of alcoholic

3 beverages may not paint, improve, or remodel a retailer's building

4 or any part of a retailer's building, inside or out, or finance any

5 <u>improvements to a retailer's building</u>.

6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
