## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 2165, Government Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 2165.259 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 2165.259. CAPITOL COMPLEX. (a) In this section,
- 7 "Capitol complex" has the meaning assigned by Section 443.0071.
- 8 (b) Notwithstanding Subchapter D, the commission may not
- 9 lease, sell, or otherwise dispose of real property or an interest in
- 10 real property located in the Capitol complex.
- 11 (c) This section does not affect the commission's authority
- 12 under Subchapter E to lease space in state office buildings and
- 13 parking garages.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 2267.003, Government Code, as added by
- 15 Chapter 1334 (S.B. 1048), Acts of the 82nd Legislature, Regular
- 16 Session, 2011, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 2267.003. APPLICABILITY. This chapter does not apply
- 18 to:
- 19 (1) the financing, design, construction, maintenance,
- 20 or operation of a highway in the state highway system;
- 21 (2) a transportation authority created under Chapter
- 22 451, 452, 453, or 460, Transportation Code; [<del>or</del>]
- 23 (3) any telecommunications, cable television, video
- 24 service, or broadband infrastructure other than technology

- 5 SECTION 3. Section 31.155(d), Natural Resources Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (d) The duty under this subchapter of the division to review
- 8 and verify real property records and to make recommendations
- 9 regarding real property and of the commissioner to prepare a report
- 10 involving real property does not apply to:
- 11 (1) the real property of an institution of higher
- 12 education;
- 13 (2) the real property that is part of a fund created or
- 14 specifically authorized by the constitution of this state and that
- 15 is administered by or with the assistance of the land office;
- 16 (3) the real property of the Employees Retirement
- 17 System of Texas; [and]
- 18 (4) the real property of the Teacher Retirement System
- 19 of Texas; and
- 20 (5) the real property located in the Capitol complex,
- 21 <u>as defined by Section 443.0071, Government Code</u>.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
