 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to the reexamination of an applicant for a professional
 1-22 counselor license.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 503.307, Occupations
 1-25 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-26 (b) An applicant who has failed three [~~two~~] successive
 1-27 examinations may not reapply for another examination before:

1-28 (1) the second anniversary of the date of the last
 1-29 examination taken by the applicant; or

1-30 (2) the date the applicant has satisfactorily
 1-31 completed nine graduate semester hours in the applicant's weakest
 1-32 portion of the examination.

1-33 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-34 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-35 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-36 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-37 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
