- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subsection (e), Section 50D.011, Agriculture 7 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (e) <u>Subject to Section 50D.017, the</u> [<del>The</del>] policy council is 9 subject to Chapters 551 and 2001, Government Code.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 50D, Agriculture Code, is amended by adding Sections 50D.016 and 50D.017 to read as follows:
- Sec. 50D.016. QUORUM. A quorum of the policy council
  consists of not less than half of the members of the policy council.
- 14 A member who participates in a meeting by telephone conference
- 15 call, videoconference, or other similar telecommunication method
- 16 may be counted to establish a quorum.
- 17 Sec. 50D.017. MEETING BY TELECONFERENCE.
- 18 (a) Notwithstanding Chapter 551, Government Code, or any other
- 19 law, the policy council may hold an open or closed meeting by
- 20 <u>telephone</u> conference call, <u>videoconference</u>, or other <u>similar</u>
- 21 <u>telecommunication method if:</u>
- 22 <u>(1) notice is given for the meeting as for other</u>
- 23 meetings;

- 2 (3) each part of the meeting that is required to be

- SECTION 4. Subchapter C, Chapter 50D, Agriculture Code, is
- 17 amended by adding Sections 50D.025 and 50D.026 to read as follows:
- Sec. 50D.025. QUORUM. A quorum of the research committee
- 19 consists of not less than half of the members of the research
- 20 committee. A member who participates in a meeting by telephone
- 21 conference call, videoconference, or other similar
- 22 telecommunication method may be counted to establish a quorum.
- 23 <u>Sec. 50D.026. MEETING</u> BY <u>TELECONFERENCE.</u>
- 24 (a) Notwithstanding Chapter 551, Government Code, or any other
- 25 law, the research committee may hold an open or closed meeting by
- 26 <u>telephone</u> conference call, videoconference, or other similar
- 27 telecommunication method if:

- 1 (1) notice is given for the meeting as for other
- 2 meetings;
- 3 (2) the notice specifies a location for the meeting at
- 4 which the public may attend;
- 5 (3) each part of the meeting that is required to be
- 6 open to the public is audible to the public at the location
- 7 specified in the notice of the meeting; and
- 8 <u>(4) the meeting is recorded by electronic or other</u>
- 9 means and the recording of each portion of the meeting that is
- 10 required to be open to the public is made available to the public.
- 11 (b) A member of the research committee may participate by
- 12 <u>telephone</u> conference call, videoconference, or other similar
- 13 <u>telecommunication method in a research committee meeting at which</u>
- 14 other members are physically present and may vote.
- 15 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
