2	relating to strategic plans to address hunger, food, nutrition, and
3	obesity in this state.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 12, Agriculture Code, is amended by
6	adding Section 12.00251 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 12.00251. STRATEGIC PLAN FOR ADDRESSING HUNGER, FOOD,
8	NUTRITION, AND OBESITY. The department shall develop a strategic
9	plan that includes as a goal of the department addressing hunger,
10	food, nutrition, and obesity in this state by:

- 11 (1) increasing access to nutritious foods by persons
- 12 <u>in this state;</u>
- 13 (2) increasing access to and participation in the
- 14 national free or reduced-price lunch program established under 42
- 15 U.S.C. Section 1751 et seq. by persons eligible for the program;
- 16 (3) strengthening the department's education
- 17 initiatives to increase awareness of food and nutrition programs in
- 18 this state by using public service announcements; and
- 19 <u>(4) facilitating obesity prevention and diabetes</u>
- 20 <u>awareness initiatives.</u>
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 7.021, Education Code, is amended by
- 22 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- (e) The agency shall develop a strategic plan that includes
- 24 as a goal of the agency addressing hunger, food, nutrition, and

- 1 obesity in this state by:
- 2 (1) increasing access to nutritious foods by persons
- 3 served by the agency;
- 4 (2) increasing access to and participation in the
- 5 national free or reduced-price lunch program established under 42
- 6 $\underline{\text{U.S.C.}}$ Section 1751 et seq. by eligible persons served by the
- 7 agency;
- 8 (3) strengthening the agency's education initiatives
- 9 to increase awareness of food and nutrition programs in this state
- 10 by using public service announcements; and
- 11 (4) facilitating obesity prevention and diabetes
- 12 awareness initiatives.
- SECTION 3. Section 531.022, Government Code, is amended by
- 14 adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- (f) In addition to the goals specified by Subsection (c),
- 16 the plan must include as a goal of the commission, the Department of
- 17 Assistive and Rehabilitative Services, and the Department of State
- 18 Health Services addressing hunger, food, nutrition, and obesity in
- 19 this state by:
- 20 (1) increasing access to nutritious foods by persons
- 21 served by the agencies;
- 22 (2) increasing access to and participation in the
- 23 national free or reduced-price lunch program established under 42
- 24 U.S.C. Section 1751 et seq. by eligible persons served by the
- 25 agencies;
- 26 (3) strengthening each agency's education initiatives
- 27 to increase awareness of food and nutrition programs in this state

- 1 by using public service announcements; and
- 2 <u>(4) facilitating obesity prevention and diabetes</u>
- 3 <u>awareness initiatives.</u>
- 4 SECTION 4. As soon as possible after the effective date of
- 5 this Act and using existing funds:
- 6 (1) the Department of Agriculture shall develop the
- 7 strategic plan required by Section 12.00251, Agriculture Code, as
- 8 added by this Act; and
- 9 (2) the Texas Education Agency shall develop the
- 10 strategic plan required by Section 7.021(e), Education Code, as
- 11 added by this Act.
- 12 SECTION 5. The executive commissioner of the Health and
- 13 Human Services Commission shall include the goal and methods of
- 14 implementing that goal specified by Section 531.022(f), Government
- 15 Code, as added by this Act, in the first biennial update of the
- 16 coordinated strategic plan for health and human services required
- 17 by Section 531.022, Government Code, as amended by this Act, that is
- 18 required after the effective date of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
