S.B. No. 929

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to equal opportunity for access by home-schooled students
- 3 to University Interscholastic League sponsored activities;
- 4 authorizing a fee.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 33, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 33.0833 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 33.0833. EQUAL OPPORTUNITY FOR HOME-SCHOOLED STUDENTS
- 9 TO PARTICIPATE IN UNIVERSITY INTERSCHOLASTIC LEAGUE ACTIVITIES.
- 10 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (d), a public school that
- 11 participates in an activity sponsored by the University
- 12 Interscholastic League shall provide a home-schooled student who
- 13 <u>resides in the school's attendance area with the opportunity to</u>
- 14 participate in the activity on behalf of the school in the same
- 15 manner that the school provides the opportunity to participate to
- 16 students enrolled in the school.
- 17 (b) A home-schooled student who seeks to participate or who
- 18 participates in a league activity on behalf of a school is subject
- 19 to the relevant policies that apply to students enrolled in the
- 20 school, including policies regarding registration, age
- 21 eligibility, fees, insurance, transportation, physical condition,
- 22 qualifications, responsibilities, event schedules, standards of
- 23 behavior, and performance.
- 24 (c) As a condition of participation by a home-schooled

- 1 student in a league activity under this section, the individual who
- 2 primarily provides instruction to the student must submit a written
- 3 verification to the school indicating whether the student is:
- 4 (1) receiving a passing grade in each course or
- 5 subject taught; and
- 6 (2) maintaining satisfactory progress towards
- 7 <u>academic advancement or promotion.</u>
- 8 (d) A home-schooled student is not authorized by this
- 9 section to participate in a league activity during the remainder of
- 10 any school year during which the student was previously enrolled in
- 11 a public school.
- 12 (e) The University Interscholastic League may not prohibit
- 13 a home-schooled student from participating in league activities in
- 14 the manner authorized by this section.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2013-2014
- 16 school year.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
