- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 81, Natural Resources
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 81.021 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 81.021. RAILROAD COMMISSION OF TEXAS OPERATING
- 8 ACCOUNT. (a) The Railroad Commission of Texas operating account
- 9 is an account in the general revenue fund.
- 10 (b) Money in the account may be appropriated only to the
- 11 commission for the operation of the commission.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 81.058, Natural Resources Code, is
- 13 amended by adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:
- 14 (g) An administrative penalty imposed under this section
- 15 shall be deposited to the credit of the Railroad Commission of Texas
- 16 operating account established under Section 81.021.
- 17 SECTION 3. Subchapter K, Chapter 85, Natural Resources
- 18 Code, is amended by adding Section 85.390 to read as follows:
- 19 Sec. 85.390. DISPOSITION OF CERTAIN PENALTIES. A penalty
- 20 collected under Section 85.385 or 85.3855 shall be deposited to the
- 21 credit of the Railroad Commission of Texas operating account
- 22 <u>established under Section 81.021.</u>
- SECTION 4. Section 111.261, Natural Resources Code, is
- 24 amended to read as follows:

- 1 Sec. 111.261. PENALTY RECOVERABLE BY STATE. (a) A common
- 2 carrier under this chapter is subject to a penalty of not less than
- 3 \$100 nor more than $\frac{$25,000}{}$ [$\frac{$1,000}{}$] for each offense, recoverable
- 4 in the name of the state, if the common carrier:
- 5 (1) violates Section 111.013 through 111.024,
- 6 111.134, 111.135, 111.138, 111.139, 111.141, or 111.142 of this
- 7 code or a valid order of the commission; or
- 8 (2) fails to perform a duty imposed by Section 111.013
- 9 through 111.024, 111.134, 111.135, 111.138, 111.139, 111.141, or
- 10 111.142 of this code.
- 11 (b) A penalty collected under this section shall be
- 12 deposited to the credit of the Railroad Commission of Texas
- 13 operating account established under Section 81.021.
- 14 SECTION 5. Section 111.263, Natural Resources Code, is
- 15 amended by adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 16 (a-1) Except as provided by Subsection (b), a penalty
- 17 recovered under this section shall be deposited to the credit of the
- 18 Railroad Commission of Texas operating account established under
- 19 Section 81.021.
- 20 SECTION 6. Section 116.143, Natural Resources Code, is
- 21 amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 22 <u>(d) A penalty collected under this section shall be</u>
- 23 deposited to the credit of the Railroad Commission of Texas
- 24 operating account established under Section 81.021.
- 25 SECTION 7. Section 117.051, Natural Resources Code, is
- 26 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 117.051. CIVIL PENALTY. (a) A person who violates

- 1 this chapter or a rule adopted by the commission under this chapter
- 2 is subject to a civil penalty of not less than \$50 nor more than
- 3 \$25,000 for each act of violation and for each day of violation,
- 4 provided that the maximum civil penalty that may be assessed for any
- 5 related series of violations may not exceed \$500,000.
- 6 (b) A penalty collected under this section shall be
- 7 deposited to the credit of the Railroad Commission of Texas
- 8 operating account established under Section 81.021.
- 9 SECTION 8. Section 134.178, Natural Resources Code, is
- 10 amended to read as follows:
- 11 Sec. 134.178. RECOVERY OF ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY. (a) The
- 12 attorney general at the request of the commission may bring a civil
- 13 action to recover an administrative penalty owed under this
- 14 chapter.
- 15 (b) An administrative penalty collected under this chapter
- 16 shall be deposited to the credit of the Railroad Commission of Texas
- 17 operating account established under Section 81.021.
- SECTION 9. Section 141.016, Natural Resources Code, is
- 19 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 141.016. RECOVERY OF PENALTY. Civil penalties owed
- 21 under Sections 141.013-141.015 [of this code] may be recovered in a
- 22 civil action brought by the attorney general at the request of the
- 23 commission and shall be deposited on collection to the credit of the
- 24 Railroad Commission of Texas operating account established under
- 25 <u>Section 81.021</u>.
- SECTION 10. Section 105.027, Utilities Code, is amended to
- 27 read as follows:

- 1 Sec. 105.027. DISPOSITION OF FINES AND PENALTIES. A fine or
- 2 penalty collected under this subtitle, other than a fine or penalty
- 3 collected in a criminal proceeding, shall be <u>deposited</u> to the
- 4 credit of the Railroad Commission of Texas operating account
- 5 established under Section 81.021, Natural Resources Code [paid to
- 6 the railroad commission].
- 7 SECTION 11. Subchapter E, Chapter 121, Utilities Code, is
- 8 amended by adding Section 121.212 to read as follows:
- 9 <u>Sec. 121.212.</u> <u>DISPOSITION OF CERTAIN PENALTIES.</u> An
- 10 administrative or civil penalty collected under this subchapter
- 11 shall be deposited to the credit of the Railroad Commission of Texas
- 12 operating account established under Section 81.021, Natural
- 13 Resources Code.
- 14 SECTION 12. Subchapter G, Chapter 121, Utilities Code, is
- 15 amended by adding Section 121.311 to read as follows:
- 16 Sec. 121.311. DISPOSITION OF CERTAIN PENALTIES. An
- 17 administrative or civil penalty collected under this subchapter
- 18 shall be deposited to the credit of the Railroad Commission of Texas
- 19 operating account established under Section 81.021, Natural
- 20 Resources Code.
- 21 SECTION 13. Section 27.101, Water Code, is amended by
- 22 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 23 <u>(c) A penalty collected under this section shall be</u>
- 24 deposited to the credit of the Railroad Commission of Texas
- 25 operating account established under Section 81.021, Natural
- 26 Resources Code.
- 27 SECTION 14. Section 27.1014, Water Code, is amended to read

- 1 as follows:
- 2 Sec. 27.1014. RECOVERY OF PENALTY. Civil penalties owed
- 3 under Sections 27.1011-27.1013 [of this code] may be recovered in a
- 4 civil action brought by the attorney general at the request of the
- 5 railroad commission and shall be deposited on collection to the
- 6 credit of the Railroad Commission of Texas operating account
- 7 <u>established under Section 81.021, Natural Resources Code</u>.
