4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 241, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 241.009 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 241.009. PHOTO IDENTIFICATION BADGE REQUIRED. (a) In
8	this section:
9	(1) "Health care provider" means a person who provides
10	health care services at a hospital as a physician, as an employee of
11	the hospital, under a contract with the hospital, or in the course
12	of a training or educational program at the hospital.
13	(2) "Hospital" means a hospital licensed under this
14	chapter.
15	(b) A hospital shall adopt a policy requiring a health care
16	provider providing direct patient care at the hospital to wear a
17	photo identification badge during all patient encounters, unless
18	precluded by adopted isolation or sterilization protocols. The
19	badge must be of sufficient size and worn in a manner to be visible
20	and must clearly state:
21	(1) at minimum the provider's first or last name;
22	(2) the department of the hospital with which the
23	provider is associated;
24	(3) the type of license held by the provider, if the

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1	provider holds a license under Title 3, Occupations Code; and
2	(4) if applicable, the provider's status as a student,
3	intern, trainee, or resident.
4	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2014.
