- 17 photo identification badge during all patient encounters, unless
- 18 precluded by adopted isolation or sterilization protocols. The
- 19 badge must be of sufficient size and worn in a manner to be visible
- 20 and must clearly state:

- 22 (2) the department of the hospital with which the
