## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to requiring certain alcoholic beverage permittees to be 3 the primary source of supply for certain alcoholic beverages.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 37.10, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is 6 amended to read as follows:

7 Sec. 37.10. RESTRICTION AS TO SOURCE OF SUPPLY. (a) No 8 holder of a nonresident seller's permit may solicit, accept, or 9 fill an order for distilled spirits or wine from a holder of any 10 type of wholesaler's <u>or winery</u> permit unless the nonresident seller 11 is the primary [<u>American</u>] source of supply for the brand of 12 distilled spirits or wine that is ordered.

13 In this section, "primary [American] source of supply" (b) 14 means the distiller, the producer, the owner of the commodity at the time it becomes a marketable product, the bottler, or the exclusive 15 16 agent of any of those. To be the "primary [American] source of supply" the nonresident seller must be the sole [first] source, 17 18 that is, the manufacturer or the source closest to the manufacturer, in the channel of commerce from whom the product can 19 20 be secured by [American] wholesalers and wineries in this state.

21 SECTION 2. Sections 101.671(a) and (d), Alcoholic Beverage 22 Code, are amended to read as follows:

(a) Before an authorized permittee may ship distilledspirits or wine into the state or sell distilled spirits or wine

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within the state, the permittee must register the distilled spirits 1 or wine with the commission and provide proof that the permittee is 2 the primary source of supply, as defined by Section 37.10. 3 The 4 registration application must include a certificate of label approval issued by the United States Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and 5 6 Trade Bureau for the product. 7 The commission by rule <u>may</u> [shall] establish procedures (d) 8 for accepting: 9 (1) federal certificates of approval label for registration under this section; and 10 11 (2) proof that a permittee is a primary source of supply for purposes of this section. 12 13 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.

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
