1-19 relating to the repeal of certain offenses relating to certain
 1-20 occupations regulated by the Texas Department of Licensing and
 1-21 Regulation.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Subsection (f), Section 754.0141, Health and
 1-24 Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-25 (f) An inspection by a QEI-1 certified inspector of
 1-26 equipment in a single-family dwelling may be performed only at the
 1-27 request and with the consent of the owner. The owner of a
 1-28 single-family dwelling is not subject to Section 754.022 or [7]
 1-29 754.023 [~~or 754.024~~].

1-30 SECTION 2. The heading to Subchapter E, Chapter 91, Labor
 1-31 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-32 SUBCHAPTER E. PROHIBITED ACTS; ENFORCEMENT [~~PENALTY~~]

1-33 SECTION 3. Section 1151.253, Occupations Code, is
 1-34 transferred to Subchapter E, Chapter 1151, Occupations Code, and
 1-35 redesignated as Section 1151.206, Occupations Code, to read as
 1-36 follows:

1-37 Sec. 1151.206 [~~1151.253~~]. COMPLAINT OF VIOLATION. A
 1-38 person may file a complaint with the department concerning a
 1-39 violation of this chapter or a rule adopted by the commission under
 1-40 this chapter.

1-41 SECTION 4. The heading to Subchapter G, Chapter 2052,
 1-42 Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-43 SUBCHAPTER G. DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES; PENALTIES [~~CRIMINAL~~
 1-44 ~~OFFENSE~~]

1-45 SECTION 5. The following provisions are repealed:

- 1-46 (1) Section 754.024, Health and Safety Code;
- 1-47 (2) Section 91.063, Labor Code;
- 1-48 (3) Subchapter D, Chapter 92, Labor Code;
- 1-49 (4) the heading to Subchapter F, Chapter 1151,
 1-50 Occupations Code;
- 1-51 (5) Sections 1151.251, 1151.252, 1152.252, and
 1-52 2052.309, Occupations Code;
- 1-53 (6) Subchapter H, Chapter 1202, Occupations Code;
- 1-54 (7) Subchapter N, Chapter 1601, Occupations Code; and
- 1-55 (8) Subchapter L, Chapter 1602, Occupations Code.

1-56 SECTION 6. The repeal of an offense by this Act does not
 1-57 apply to an offense committed before the effective date of the
 1-58 repeal. An offense committed before the effective date of the
 1-59 repeal is governed by the law as it existed on the date the offense
 1-60 was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that
 1-61 purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed

2-1 before the effective date of the repeal if any element of the
2-2 offense occurred before that date.

2-3 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
2-4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
2-5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
2-6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
2-7 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
